

Library Services

The Sydney Campus Academies Australasia Polytechnic library, with prescribed textbooks, is located on level 7, at 333 Kent Street, Sydney. Any Academies Australasia Polytechnic student wishing to borrow books may do so between 9:00am - 5:00pm, weekdays.

You will be required to present your **AAPoly Student Identification Card** when borrowing books.

There is a diverse range of information resources available in and via the Library and as part of our growing online collection. AAPoly's Information Resource Coordinator can provide guidance on navigating the library and the online collections.

All required subject-based resources are provided within our base of electronic resources. Online journals, newspapers and electronic databases are currently being provided by EBSCO (including a wide range of e-books and magazines via Flipster). Students also have access to the Gale Academic One File international journals, Sage Research Methods, JSTOR, Informit and Oxford Reference Online. More general learning resources and resources to support the English language development are also available through the Library.

External Libraries

The City of Sydney Library is located at 31 Alfred Street, Circular Quay, NSW 2000 or 744 George Street, Sydney NSW 2000 – both of which are located near to our 333 Kent Street campus in Sydney.

The State Library of New South Wales is a large reference and research library open to the public. Corner of Macquarie Street and Shakespeare Place, Sydney. Students can take part in free research orientation programs and self-guided visits. There are also tailored sessions for help with coursework or research degrees. Students can book a one-on-one consultation for help with a tricky research question.
