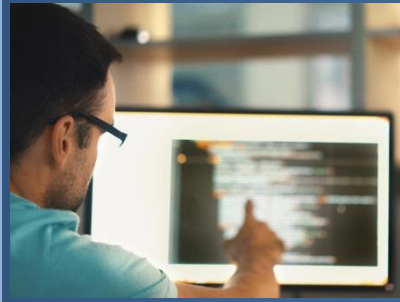

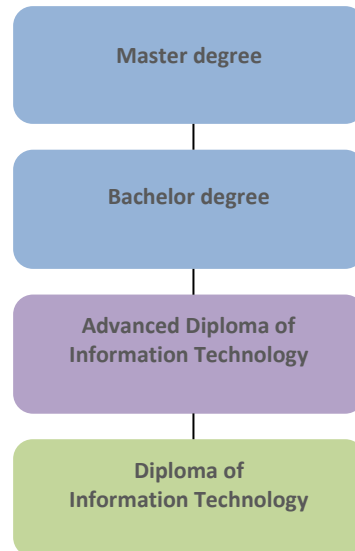


## Recognition of Prior Learning
